Advance notification of MBS changes

ENSURING APPROPRIATE USE OF NEUROSURGERY AND NEUROLOGY SERVICES

- What? The changes include a restructuring of items for neurosurgery and neurology services, including the addition of new items, deletion of existing items, and minor amendments to existing items and explanatory notes.
- Why? MBS items for neurosurgery and neurology will be changing to facilitate provision of effective, evidencebased neurosurgery and neurology services to ensure that services are clinically appropriate and reflect modern practice.
- **Who?** These changes are relevant for all specialists involved in the management of neurosurgery and neurology services, consumers claiming these services, and private health insurers.
- When? The changes to neurosurgery and neurology services will be effective on or after 1 November 2020. These changes are subject to legislative processes. Further details, including full item descriptors, will be released as soon as the changes are confirmed.
